Fostering Essentials



Every 2 minutes a child enters foster care...

- Providing a foster closet with a full inventory of items a child needs while in foster care from clothing to infant equipment.

Fostering Connections



30 - 50% of foster parents quit in first year - many citing lack of support

- Support Groups for Caregivers
- Hair Care Fundamentals Class
- Resource Navigation for families

Fostering Safety



49% of car seats are installed or used incorrectly

- Providing brand new car seats when caregivers complete a child safety seat course
- Providing incentives for car seat check ups


Fostering Independence
